Public invited to review proposed instructional materials and textbooks

COLUMBIA – The public is invited to review textbooks and instructional materials that have been proposed for use in South Carolina’s public schools.

The materials will be recommended to the State Board of Education for adoption on December 9, 2009, by the Instructional Materials Review Panels appointed by the Board. The materials are in the following subject areas:

- Algebra 1 and 2
- Geometry
- Mathematics for the Technologies 1, 2, and 3

The textbooks and instructional materials will be on display through Nov. 8 at 23 colleges and universities throughout the state. Evaluation forms for citizens’ comments are available at each site, and the State Board of Education will review those comments before deciding whether to adopt the materials.
